Ms. Cindy Breaux, CFO explained that the Financial Report includes preliminary numbers for the Final FY22 Budget. Ms. Breaux is awaiting confirmation from the accounting auditors to schedule a final audit to close out the FY22 Budget.

Supervisor Marlin Ladner noted that the budget reflects 32% above budget in the repairs category.

Mr. John Wilson explained that the Riverhills location went from an inactive to active in one year and exercising versus running 24/7, makes a difference and the plant was dormant for (8) years prior placing in service. There was an increase due to raising blowers on pedestals due to flood waters. The Financial Report does not reflect FEMA reimbursements due to Zeta and Ida.
