Mr. Marlin Ladner asked, in regards to the Debt Service, the status of pipe that was run to D'Iberville Highschool several years ago, if we were getting any revenue from that connection. Mr. Al Gombos answered that the Highschool was not connected to the City of D'Iberville Water and Sewer system, that they are still utilizing an emergency, on-site water and sewer system instead of connecting. Mr. John Wilson explained that there had been no discussion regarding connecting into the line with the current School Board President, and that previously when they talked about tying in their sewer, but not water, that was not an option as the City of D'Iberville policy does not allow that, it must be both. The Board would like us to address this issue with the District and current School Board.

H. Solid Waste Report

Mr. Alan Lane explained that the recycling participation rate is at 43.5%.

Mr. John Wilson added that HCUA is currently looking into a way to obtain the larger volume, 65 gallon recycling carts; we currently have nine years left on this contact and we could purchase 1/9th of the carts for our current residents each year.

Mayor Jimmy Rafferty asked if we respond to the negative comments that sometimes appear on our social media pages. Mr. John Wilson told him that yes, we do monitor the comments and, if need be, respond via private message to those types of comments, but that we try and avoid any back and forth on the public page.

I. Executive Director's Report

Mr. John Wilson reported that we are still awaiting the results from the testing we did for the PFAS (Forever) Chemicals, and that the EPA has proposed new directives and standards (4 parts per trillion) and we will use this suggested standard as our baseline to compare our results to.

Mr. Marlin Ladner asked what sort of scientific evidence is there connecting these chemicals to adverse health effects? Mr. Jim Simpson explained that at this time there is no firm, concrete data connecting these chemicals to negative health effects. J. Executive Session
