F1a. N. D'Iberville Pump Station & Manhole - Discussion

Mr. John Wilson reported that the repairs to the manhole had been completed and lined with a fiberglass liner, as of July 22, 2025 the system is active. All of the other receiving manholes in the Authority's custody have been inspected and added to the asset management report. There was one manhole in Long Beach that found to be in need of repair and that is being addressed. Mr. Al Gombos asked for a detailed report on the N. D'Iberville PS Manhole, which Mr. Wilson assured him he would get, and Supervisor Dan Cuevas asked what the shelf life for the fiberglass liners. Mr. Wilson explained that the liner had a ten year warranty, while the manhole itself has a 20-25 year lifespan.

Mr. John Wilson explained that the salary adjustments would include a 5% increase for ten employees, and 3% for three others, for a total increase of \$28,000.000. Mayor Tim Pierce asked how raises are usually determined. Mr. Wilson explained that in years previous the raises that employees received were based on changing positions and job responsibilities, some positions were eliminated and those responsibilities were spread onto other employees. This is the first year that raises are being done based strictly on merit and cost of living.

Mr. John Wilson reported that the only real changes to the budget were that D'Iberville had asked for some money for projects be added to the budget, and the city of Long Beach was revised to show money being rolled in but not adding new money, so those two things were corrected and updated. The only other thing we are waiting on are the final Solid Waste numbers, but the budget has numbers in there to reflect those numbers.

Mr. Al Gombos asked how much the Authority pays per Garbage cart, Mr. Alan Lane explained that we pay \$23.57, which includes garbage and recycling, disposal, and yard waste.

Supervisor Marlin Ladner also asked if the Authority had settled the lawsuits related to the S-14 Project. Mr. Jim Simpson informed them that the Authority has settled all lawsuits, except for the Underhill lawsuit where a landowner has sued the City of Gulfport and the Authority. All disbursements from any settlements have been dispersed to the Members and the Authority.
